EMERGENCY AMENDMENT TO THE NEZ PERCE TRIBAL CODE

Emergency Amendment effective July 7, 2015, authorized by NPTEC

This notice is being posted July 7, 2015, according to the Nez Perce Tribal Code § 1-4-2 to request written comments for the following emergency amendment (see below):

Chapter 4-3 Civil Infractions

§4-3-72 Firework Ordinance

A person commits the offense or violation of the Nez Perce Fireworks Ordinance by:

...

(m) Any person discharging fireworks after the Nez Perce Tribal Executive Committee imposes a ban as authorized under §6-3-8.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: Due to the extremely dry and hazardous conditions, there was a need for an immediate amendment to Chapter 4-3 Civil Infractions, § 4-3-72 to add language to make it unlawful for anyone to discharge fireworks after the NPTEC has imposed a ban as authorized by the Fireworks Ordinance §6-3-8 Right to Close Fireworks Season.
