#### MEAL PROGRAM

The program provides meals on a daily basis (week days only, closed on holiday.) Approved elders 55+ years of age to apply. For home deliveries are based on frail/handicapped, with a physical medical need that prevent you from dining-in, and may require a physician's approval for home delivery. Applications are available at Chief Joseph or Chief Looking Glass dining hall.

Dining-in is provided at Chief Joseph & Chief Looking Glass Complex (when permissible) on a daily basis from 11:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. A food tray to go may be picked up daily (when permissible).

#### **TRAVEL**

Travel is provided for elders (when permissible.) Travel information is provided in the meal application. You must be an approved elder to utilize travel services.
