Agnes Fern Broncheau Memorial Scholarship List

*The family of Agnes Fern Broncheau want to honor their mother who was very active in her community, achieved her Bachelor's Degree in Social Work and became a Drug & Alcohol Counselor. This scholarship was created in her name to be administered to a Nez Perce Tribal Member who is in recovery from Alcohol and/or Drugs and pursuing a higher education. The applicant will need to submit "proof of treatment completion" certificate with their application or "proof of current out-patient treatment attendance." ***

1. Each school year, there will be one (1) \$200 scholarship for a Nez Perce tribal member who is "clean and sober." Must have proof of completion of in-patient treatment.
2. Each school year, there will be one (1) \$500 scholarship for a Nez Perce tribal member who is currently attending out-patient treatment.
3. Student should be enrolled as Full-time status according to school definition, at an accredited school.
4. The application deadline will be September 30 by 4:30 pm.
5. Criteria:
 - a. Must be a Nez Perce Tribal Member.
 - b. Application must provide verification of enrollment in college.
 - c. Applicant is only eligible to receive this scholarship one-time only.
6. Application must include:
 - a. Completed application
 - b. Transcript showing class schedule
 - c. Essay on how they plan to give back to the Tribe through maintaining sobriety or attending recovery or well-briety meetings on the reservation.
 - d. One (1) Letters of recommendation
 - e. Proof of Tribal enrollment
 - f. Proof of Treatment completion in Alcohol/Drug Treatment. (Certificate, Award, etc.) or Proof of current In-patient Treatment Attendance (letter from Counselor, etc.).
7. Application should include:
 - a. Personal information
 - b. Honors & Awards received by applicant
 - c. Release of Information decision
8. The Nez Perce Tribe Education Department will be responsible for reviewing applications, in consultation with the family of Agnes Broncheau, and distributing the scholarship. Confidentiality of applicant information will be a top priority. One's name will only be announced as a scholarship recipient, if the applicant initialed the release of information in the application form.
