The Nez Perce Tribe authorized Resolution #NP 22-073 to implement a vaccination policy effective December 6, 2021. All new hired employees will be required to provide proof of vaccination and a signed medical release form for verification purposes. New employees will be separated from employment if proof of vaccination is found to be altered or forged. Exemptions are not available for new hire employees.

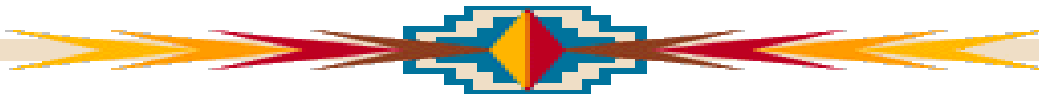

Active job seekers will be screened accordingly and referred to temporary appointments based on education, qualifications and experience. Tribal/Indian preference applies. Certain positions may require a valid driver's license with ability to be insurable under the Tribe's policy.

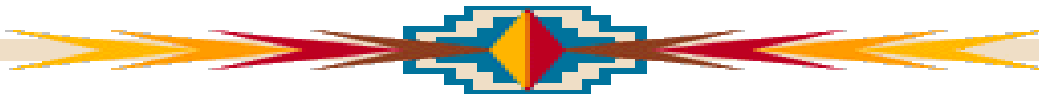

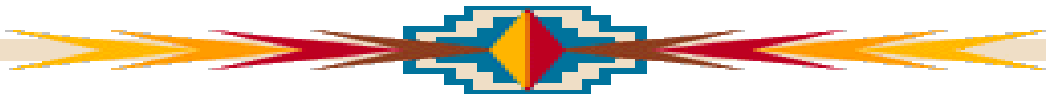
