# PATHWAY

Indian Health Service (IHS) has found Native populations suffer disproportionately from heart disease, diabetes, alcoholism, mental health conditions, asthma, chronic liver disease and intrahepatic bile duct cancer. Among other factors, these health disparities can be attributed to a shortage of Native physicians and other health care professionals. Practitioners with knowledge of and sensitivity to the traditions of these communities can improve the health care that is delivered. By increasing the total number of Native medical and health science students we can in turn decrease health disparities and improve public health among our Native community.


