

FY2023 GSA RATE - MEALS, INCIDENTALS, MILEAGE



All travel will generally comply with General Services Administration (“GSA”) travel regulations, published online in the Federal Register (<http://www.gsa.gov/portal/category/26429>). Below are current rates for 1) Meals & Incidental Expenses (M&IE), which vary depending on the travel destination, and 2) mileage reimbursement when using Privately Owned Vehicles (“POVs”) while on tribal business.
