The purpose of the class is to oversee and direct accounting functions in compliance with generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP). The class is responsible for the preparation, disbursement, maintenance, review, interpretation, analysis, and reconciliation of budgets, financial records, bank accounts, funds, grants, audits, and financial statements, and for staff supervision and reporting. The class works within broad policy and organizational guidelines; independently plans and implements projects; reports progress of major activities through periodic conferences and meetings. Requires bachelor's degree in accounting, Business, Public Administration, or Finance (master's and/or CPA preferred). Must be able to obtain a Nez Perce Tribal Gaming License (subject to complete background check). Requires a valid driver's license with the ability to be insured under the Tribe's policy (**must provide copy of driver's license and a motor vehicle report of ENTIRE driving record (MVR)**). CPA credential preferred. Requires three (3) years of supervisory experience. Requires five (5) years of experience in senior-level finance or accounting position. Knowledge of finance, accounting, budgeting, and cost control principles including Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP), knowledge of automated financial and accounting reporting systems, knowledge of federal and state financial regulations. Ability to analyze financial data and prepare financial reports, statements, and projections. Working knowledge of short- and long-term budgeting and forecasting, rolling budgets, and product-line profitability analysis. 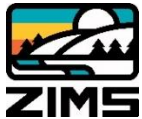
